#### WOMEN'S URINARY HEALTH PROBLEMS

Mohamed offers a range of approaches to the management of urinary incontinence, including investigations of incontinence (urodynamic and video-urodynamic assessment), intravesical Botox injection and minimally invasive tension-free vaginal tape. He also manages bladder conditions, such as interstitial cystitis (painful bladder), kidney infections (pyelonephritis) and urinary tract infections, single and recurrent.

#### MEN'S HEALTH PROBLEMS

He has a range of services for the management of bladder problems, erection and ejaculation problems, male andropause and low testosterone. These include early detection and management of prostate cancer; minimally invasive and surgical management of benign prostatic enlargement, including medical treatment; Greenlight laser prostate vaporisation; transurethral resection of the prostate and transurethral vaporisation of the prostate. He also treats and manages male infertility, vasectomy and vasectomy reversal.

#### GENERAL UROLOGY

Mohamed investigates and manages haematuria (blood in the urine), bladder cancer, and foreskin, testicular and scrotal problems.
